If your horse is located at an address significantly different from the Owner address - please provide the location of the horse for determining inspection sites.

Please send in the application and the inspection fee by May 1. The number and location of the inspection sites will be determined based on paid applications postmarked no later than May 1, 2019. Registration need not be complete to send in an application for inspection. However, completed registration will be required prior to inspection. Applications postmarked after July 15, 2019 must include a \$75.00 late fee per horse. No applications will be accepted in the 3 weeks preceding inspections, and all paperwork must be complete and fees paid by that time.
